EXPERIENCES BY CATEGORIES

BETWEEN 2012 AND NOVEMBER 2019

CREATIVE MINISTRY

- Created the "5 Days of Prayers," a 5-day-1-hour-a-day online Facebook live experience of guided silent, meditative prayer
- Developed and refined the Sunday worship service into a life-giving, Jesus-centred experience
- Orchestrated and led a Facebook Live Worship Experience during the snow storm (with leaders co-leading remotely)
- Creative approaches to ministry (pedals on the cross)
- Design and build an email campaign to engage event registrants weeks prior to the start of event
- Planned and executed on an 11-week long Alpha program which enjoys 90% of Sunday service attendance participation with 10% first time visitors

PASTORAL CARE

- Prayed for and checked in with key leaders regularly
- Helped people discover the presence of Jesus in the midst of life's difficulties
- Engaged in one-on-one mentoring conversations
- Hosted dinners for key leaders and recently-settled newcomers
- Primary pastoral audience ranges from youth to married couples with teenage children
- Mentored young parents through the Alpha Parenting Course

LEADERS & VOLUNTEER DEVELOPMENT

- Trained small group leaders, worship team leaders and bands on worship theology and best practices
- Designed and recorded short how-to videos (posted to Vimeo) for repeatable learning for volunteers
- Created space for discussions and expanded leaders' capacity on leadership and ministry structure through materials such as "Breaking 200"

STRUCTURE & PLANNING

- Developed written ministry plans for various ministries
- Developed "Vision Document" encapsulating core values, vision, mission, direction, and game plan
- Build processes through systems and web forms to automate recurring tasks such as announcements requests, Sunday service rosters, and etc
- Evaluated various software offerings for cost effectiveness, ease of use and scalability and decided on the Elvanto Church App as the suitable solution for volunteer and congregation engagement, demographic information storage, form-creation, and event-creation purposes

LEADERSHIP

- Co-leading my family with my wife to follow Jesus, reflecting frequently on God's work in our lives
- Prayerfully discerned vision, mission, and direction
- Led a team of ministry lay leaders through vision alignment and ministry implementation/execution
- Took on the role of primary vision guardian
- Navigated the complexities of communications and messaging between two congregations in an ethnic church setting
- Applied organizational structure dynamically and adaptively: forming the necessary teams to cope with the onslaught of challenges of an ever-changing culture. For example, successfully transitioned from a small core team into an expanded structure where ministry leads handle day-to-day ministry demands
- Planned for the long term development of the church (E.g., created a pre-teen group to address the faith development gap between children and teenagers)
- Led and facilitated staff meetings and weekly touchpoint meetings (setting agendas, following up on action items)

FRUITS, BY GOD'S GRACE

- Established partnership with community organizers such as Scarborough Rosewood Food Drive and Scarborough Rosewood Food Association, Agincourt Community Services Association to host community events and food drives
- Displayed consistent, year-over-year Sunday Service attendance growth (300% over 7 years)
- Directly involved in shepherding 15+ baptisms
- Witnessed and is part of numerous character-building, faith-deepening stories of life change
